the Lord supplied him with His grace.


**2 Corinthians 12:9**

The devil is looking for the Christian who relies on their flesh for deliverance, they're an easy mark. 
oring to keep his promises. The world hates everything that is right and just because it's contrary to their agenda.

Folks, we cannot stop people from hating us unless we compromise our convictions. Can't we all just get along? Only if we all agree with the Words of Jesus. We will not be able to walk with those who hate our Lord.
