Revealed Knowledge

Just days after I was filled with the Holy Ghost, I began to pray in tongues the whole day long as I was working as a welder in a manufacturing plant. I had sought for the gift for three years and when He finally came I just loved to pray in other tongues. As I prayed, something unexpected began to happen with me, whenever I paused the Lord would speak something to me. I never heard an audible voice, He spoke to me in my thoughts, what I heard I could never have come up with on my own. I began to write down what He told me and share them with my mentors, they were amazed at what I had received from the Lord.

John 16:13 When the Spirit of Truth is come, He will guide (lead) you into all truth: for He will not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He hears, that shall He speak.

You cannot see nor touch the Holy Spirit, but He will speak to you if you believe. You are a spirit, God created you so you could hear His voice; this isn't anything to marvel at, it's just God's way. Some ungodly people think you're insane if you claim to hear God's voice, but I say you are blessed. How could God lead us if He couldn't communicate with us? When the Lord began to speak to me I didn't know He had a plan and a purpose for

everything He spoke to me. Later on He called me into the office of the teacher and I was already armed with the things He wanted taught to His people. Despite these wonderful revelations, I was met with opposition, people who did not have revealed knowledge wanted to argue and debate.

Luke 4:4 It is written, man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word of God.

Ignorant people were opposing the very Word God was giving them in order to have the abundant life. The Lord instructed me to show His Word and let them choose to believe or not. Forcing a person to believe something even if it is the truth is not Christianity. Every Christian must choose what they will accept, the Lord can only offer His truth. If God commanded everyone to believe, then Christianity would become legalism. As an old school Catholic, I was commanded to

abstain from meat on Friday or go to hell, this is legalism.

1 Corinthians 12:3 I give you to understand, that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

When a Christian is convinced that Jesus is the Son of God and that He was crucified and raised from the dead, this person had heard from the Holy Ghost. If God will speak one thing to you, He will speak everything to you. God does not care what your title is, He will speak to whosoever wants to hear Him. Once you begin to hear His voice you will never be alone again, you will always have someone to converse with. God is not like men, He speaks very little but what He says translates into volumes of revelation. I simply ask the Lord for a nugget to chew on and it becomes a letter of vital information. Needless to say, I love revealed knowledge and I'm addicted to it.



Lead Me, O Lord

Based on His promise we must not be moved by circumstances because they are all subject to change.

If a man chooses to be led of the Spirit, he will need to hear the voice of the Lord. I never seek the voice of God just for the sake of hearing His voice. I seek Him because I want to please Him and I don't want to get off into the weeds.

Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

This is what this Scripture is saying: if you choose to be led of the Spirit, God will deal with you as if you are His son because you are. A good son listens to his Father and he does what the Father tells him. I don't hear God's voice as much as I sense His inward witness.

Let me explain how the inward witness manifests, I just suddenly know some-

before he tugs on the reins. The closer we draw to our Lord and the more will we are to be led, the quicker we hear Him.

Psalm 26:2 Examine me O Lord, and prove me, try my reins and my heart.

In this Psalm, David is praying to the Lord and telling Him that he is ready and available to be instructed. I believe we should officially ask the Lord to lead us, don't just assume that He will. We must give the Lord permission to lead and correct us, this is the prayer of submission David prayed. I think some Christians are afraid to let God lead them, they think He will lead them to do something that will make them uncomfortable.

David proved that we can trust the Lord, so he is encouraging us to allow Him to lead us through this life. If God tells you to do something you will benefit. God can see into the spirit realm, He can see what the devil is plotting and He can see the angels He dispatched to watch over us. When someone loves you as much as Jesus does you can put all your trust in Him.

Jeremiah 29:11 I know the thoughts that I think toward you saith the Lord, thoughts of peace and not evil, to give you an expected end.

God knows what He thinks of us and He is making those thoughts known to us. He has already planned out our future and knows how it will end, with a peaceful settlement. Based on His promise we must not be moved by circumstances because they are all subject to change. Like Yogi Berra use to say, "it aint over till it's over!" Jerry Savelle calls being led of the Spirit an adventure in faith. The more you commit to the Lord the more success you see, and the more success you see the more confident you become. After awhile you can't imagine being led any other way, you crave it, you can't live without Him. When God led Israel out of Egypt, He led them into a place where they had to trust Him for their sustenance. They never did trust Him, that whole generation wandered around in the wilderness until they died.


1 Timothy 4:1 The Holy Spirit warns us in the last days many will depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils.
