## Sowing for Love

The Holy Spirit revealed to me that two young people did not feel loved, I prayed for them. After the meeting was ended the Lord further expounded on the subject of love. He told me this: if you enter a room full of people and you make "them" the most important people in the room you will attract love. Everyone wants to be loved, but how many folks are willing to love?

**Philippians 2:3 Don't do anything from selfish ambition or from a cheap desire to boast, but be humble towards one another, always considering others better than yourselves.**

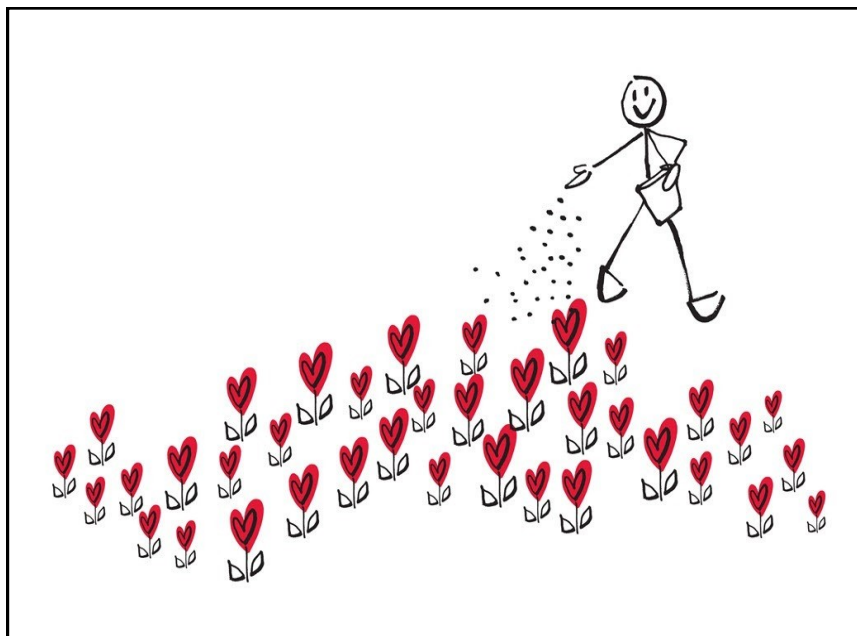
If you want to be loved, then love those people that you're around all the time. This is covered by the law of sowing and reaping, a lot of people want to reap but they are unwilling to sow. You can always identify these folks, they are those who grumble and complain about nearly everything. One of the fruits of a person who loves is contentment, loving others is its own reward.

**1 John 3:14 We know that we have left death and come over into life; we know it because we love our brothers and sisters. Whoever does not love is still under the power of death.**

After we are born-again we will put off the old man that thrived on hatred, the Holy Spirit empowers us to make such a transition. If we resist our new nature that comes from the Holy Ghost we put our salvation up for debate! We cannot continue as the same person after receiving Jesus, perhaps our salvation was in word only! The entire reason for asking Jesus into our lives is to separate ourselves from the devil and his hatred for God and people. Love is the evidence that we have passed from death to life, satan is the Lord of death, Jesus is the Lord of eternal life!

**1 John 3:15 All who hate others are murderers, and you know that murderers have not got eternal life in them.**

Realistically love does not manifest instantly in a born-again Christian. If the new believer will make time for his new Lord, Jesus will begin to supernaturally influence him. The desire to hate begins to wane because the devil has no place, no position from which to feed the demon of hatred. Now, love begins to envelop us, a love that is beyond man's natural ability. The God kind of love is an empowerment that if accepted is very difficult to resist. God used His love to break through our shell of hatred and resistance. Love is very hard to resist, you would have to get help from the devil in order to oppose it.



# The Love of God

God had to define what love is because it cannot be based on a feeling.

The natural human kind of love is a selfish kind of love, it is possessive by nature. Some folks live and grow in a home where there is no resemblance of love. Others live in homes that have varying degrees of love. No matter how you were raised you will need to learn the God kind of love.

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Love endures with patience and is kind, it is not jealous. Love is not rude or arrogant. It is not self-seeking, not easily angered, does not carry a grudge. Does not celebrate injustice, loves the truth. Love believes all things and always looks for the best in everyone.

God had to define what love is because it cannot be based on a feeling. We must practice love whether

we feel like it or not, it is not a natural born trait in any man. Love is the fundamental respect we have for our fellow man regardless of how we "feel". Jesus loves all sinners but He still came to die for us, He knew we were powerless to help ourselves. God commands us to love all men and He knows we cannot obey Him because our nature has been affected by demonic powers.

Romans 5:5 The love of God is poured out into our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is a gift given to us at the new birth.

All born-again Christians have the love of God abiding within them. We can let it flow out or we can suppress it, either way we will reap what we sow.

Christians who want to please their Savior will use every gift God gives them to bring Him glory. God will never tell us to do something we are not able to perform, He would be unjust to leave us powerless.

John 13:34 A new commandment I give you, that you love one another, as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

So, now do we have eleven commandments? No, we do not! God gave Moses the ten commandments, whoever kept them would walk in love. The ten commandments are far more than a bunch of dos and don'ts, they are an occasion to love one another. So, what Jesus is saying here is this: if you love one another you will keep or fulfill all ten of the commandments.

Galatians 5:6 In Christ neither circumcision or uncircumcision availeth anything; but faith which works by love.

Faith is believing God and then speaking what God says. Anybody could capitalize on this principle, even sinners and those seeking revenge. But if faith isn't founded in love it won't work, thank God.

Love is the desire to benefit others, at the expense of self. Selfishness is the desire to benefit self at the expense of others.

Often times Christians struggle to forgive and what they need to do is develop their love walk. Jesus did not agree with all men but He loved all men. God's love is not an option, we cannot have the God kind of life without the God kind of love.

**James 4:8** Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you.

**Galatians 5:6** In Christ neither circumcision or uncircumcision avail anything: but faith which worketh by love.
